PURPLE

BLUE

WHITE

RED

What the religious leaders didn’t realize was that his death had been prophesied hundreds of years earlier. Jesus came for this purpose. BLACK

The king was dead. But how could he die the death of a criminal? The Bible says that sin earns death for the guilty (Romans 6:23), but Jesus had never sinned, so how could he die? What they didn’t realize was that he had not died for his own sins. No, he had died for **our** sins. Jesus was the sinless substitute, the only one who could take the penalty for sin that you and I deserve. **BLACK BECAUSE OF JESUS' DEATH & OUR SIN THAT CAUSED IT**

GREEN

But what was the outcome of killing the sinless and eternal king? Because he did not have to die for his own sins, he was able to die for ours. Because he is eternal, he was able to pay the eternal penalty that our sin demands. Once our sins were paid for, the tomb could not contain him, and nothing could keep him dead. YELLOW
